# **ANIL KAPOOR**

With a career spanning over 30 years, Anil Kapoor has established himself as one of India's preeminent actors, appearing in iconic Bollywood films including *Tezaab*, *Woh Saat Din*, *Mr. India*, *Virasat* and *Loafer* before making his Hollywood debut as the quiz show host in the Oscarwinning *Slumdog Millionaire*, as well as producing films such as *Aisha* and the critically acclaimed *Gandhi My Father*.

Anil Kapoor introduces his latest film, Dil Dhadakne Do (Let The Heart Beat) on Sunday August 16 at 8pm.



#### SHONALI BOSE

Winner of the FIPRESCI Critics Award and a National Film Award, Shonali Bose's latest film *Margarita, With a Straw* won the Best Script award at Sundance's Writer's lab and premiered at Toronto. Since graduating from UCLA, filmmaker Shonali Bose has seen her work screened at festivals around the world, from her first short narrative films *The Gendarme Is Here* and *Undocumented* to the feature-length doco *Lifting the Veil* and her debut dramatic feature, *Amu*.

#### **NAGESH KUKUNOOR**

A director, producer, screenwriter and actor, Nagesh Kukunoor has earned worldwide acclaim and is one of India's first independent directors, who quit his lucrative career as a chemical engineer in the US to return home and make films. His debut feature *Hyderabad Blues* (1998) won worldwide acclaim and since then his films, including 3 *Deewarein* (2003), *Iqbal* (2005) *Lakshmi* (2013) and this year's *Dhanak* have won international festival and Filmfare awards and critical acclaim for tackling India's social issues.

Nagesh Kukunoor appears at a Masterclass, 'Confessions of an Indie Auteur,' on August 23 and will do a Q&A following the screening of Dhanak on Saturday August 22<sup>nd</sup> at 730pm.



## **SONAM KAPOOR**

Indian superstar Sonam Kapoor is renowned for her celebrated sense of style and outspoken humour. Her strong choice of roles is helping her redefine how Indian women are portrayed on screen. She won critical acclaim for her debut performance in 2007's *Saawariya* and has since starred in *Raanjhaana*, *Bhaag Milka Bhaag* and recent blockbuster *Khoobsurat*. She was GQ Woman of the Year and Vogue's Beauty of the Year in 2013.

#### **KIKU SHARDA**

One of India's most successful and popular TV comedians and drag performers, Kiku Sharda is the star of multiple hit shows thanks to his iconic characters and catch-phrases. ## RajKumar Hirani

Arguably India's most successful contemporary director, Hirani started his journey as a writer and working in advertising, before going on to create a string of influential hits. His skill at tackling weighty subjects with a populist touch has been demonstrated with *Lage Raho Munnabha*i which revived the values of 'Gandhism' *P.K.*, a political satire about 'God and business of God' which has broken box office records across the world.

## **IFFM AWARDS SHORTLIST**

IFFM is delighted to announce the nominees for the Indian Film Festival of Melbourne (IFFM) Awards, the first Indian cinema awards in Australia. The winners will be announced at a red carpet gala event on 15 August in the Great Hall of the National Gallery of Victoria.

Dominating the nominations, with three selections each, are *Piku* (2015), a quirky comedy about a father-daughter relationship starring Deepika Padukone and Amitabh Bachchan; *Haider* (2014), a modern-day adaptation of Shakespeare's *Hamlet*; and *Dum Laga Ke Haisha* (2015), a comedy about an unlikely romance.
